### **Announcements**

- July 31 Health Insurance Waiver deadline

## Travel to US from Schengen Area

- Travel from Schengen Area to US
  - Permitted for F-I students to re-enter without special requirements; requires valid passport, F-I visa and your Tufts I-20
  - If transiting through the Schengen Area, must be coming from a non-restricted
     COVID-19 area or have been outside of a restricted country/region for at least 14 days
- Keep track of travel updates including Centers for Disease Control and State Department – new developments happening every day regarding COVID-19

## July 24 Guidance

- Updated guidance and FAQs issued on July 24 outlining Fall
   2020 rules
- Guidance supplements and expands earlier guidance from March 9
- Sets up rules for **new** students (not in US and admitted to new programs this Fall) and **continuing** (and **transfer**) students who were in F-I status on March 9

### **New Students**

New students are students who were not in US as F-1 students during Spring
 2020 and are planning to start their programs this Fall 2020 semester

#### ∘ Fall 2020 Guidelines:

- Cannot come to US as F-I students are 100% online (however it is permitted to start online classes from home country)
- Allowed to come to US as F-1 students if classes are not 100% online (must include in-person or hybrid classes)
- Keep in mind COVID-19 travel restrictions, visa delays, etc.

# **Continuing Students**

 Continuing students are students who were already in F-I student status during Spring 2020 at Tufts and are continuing on in their programs during Fall 2020

#### Fall 2020 Guidelines:

- Allowed to re-enter / remain in US as F-1 students as long as they are enrolled full-time for Fall 2020
- Although in-person / hybrid courses are encouraged, permitted to take those classes that are most helpful for degree progress and personal safety

### **Transfer Students**

 Transfers students are students who were already in F-I student status during Spring 2020 (March 9) at another school (high school, college, or university) in the US and are starting programs at Tufts in Spring 2020

#### ◦ Fall 2020 Guidelines:

- Transfer students still inside US may transfer F-I status for Fall 2020; may take whichever classes are best for Fall 2020 semester and maintain F-I status as long as they are full-time
- Transfer students attending Tufts @ BNU will have F-I status maintained as long as they maintain full-time enrollment
- Transfer students who will remain outside the US but register for full-time classes on-line for Fall 2020: please wait for further instructions from the International Center
