Step 2: Advanced Search Page

- Upon clicking the Advanced Search button you will be redirected to the Tufts JumboSearch webpage
- You can use this page to search through the library catalog, course reserves, articles, Tufts Digital Library and other research guides.
- This page allows you to initiate a search based on any topic, title, author or creator of your choice.
- Resources are available in 5 languages; namely English, French, Spanish, Portuguese and German.
- Click on the “JumboSearch” button on the top of the page to access the advanced JumboSearch webpage

- You can use this page to search through the library catalog, course reserves, articles, Tufts Digital Library and other research guides.
- Important note: always use double quotation marks in the search bar




